## NOTES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

### 1. Introduction

The poster session offers a valuable opportunity for postgraduate students to provide a visual summary of their research and interact with interested attendees for in-depth discussions.

### 2. Date and Time

- The poster session will be held on November 26, 2022 (Saturday) from 11:00 – 11:20 am in the Exhibition Area of the Chong Yuet Ming Cultural Centre (CYMCC) at the University of Hong Kong's Main Campus. (Updated: 14 NOV 2022)

### 3. Poster Preparation

- Students are requested to print hard copies of their posters and post them themselves.
- Students are requested to post their own posters on the allocated poster board by 10 am on the event day and remove at the end of the day. Those not removed by this time will be disposed of by the event organizers.
- The Organizers will provide a bulletin board (2m in height and 1m in width), a sign indicating the paper number, and push-pins or adhesive tape for each paper.
- The poster size should be A0 portrait oriented (width: 84.1cm / 33.1 inch, Length:118.9cm / 46.8 inch). Do not exceed these dimensions.
- The Organizers have no provisions for printing posters at the event, receiving, storing, or returning poster to students.

### 4. Layout Suggestions

- Posters should be readable by viewers 2 meters away.
- The title of poster should appear at the top with font size about 72 (approximately 25mm high), followed by the name(s) of student(s) and affiliation(s). The smallest text on the poster should at least be of font size 24 (9mm high).
- Use large font size, bold font or color, etc. to highlight important points.
- Make the poster as self-explanatory as possible as students are only given 2 minutes to explain the scientific merits of the research project. (Updated: 14 NOV 2022)

### 5. Content Suggestions

- Title, poster and Paper Number, Student Name, Institutional Affiliation
- Introduction / Objectives
- Methodology
- Results/ Key Findings
- Conclusions
- Future Directions
- References
- Acknowledgements

### 6. Submission of Poster

- Students are required to submit the poster in soft copy upload to the [Paper/Poster Submission Form](#).
- Poster shall be in PDF format only.

## **7. Presenting the Poster**

- Students are required to explain to the adjudicators the most important scientific merits of the research project within 3 minutes during the assigned time.
- Students are also expected to introduce the research project to those interested in your poster and answer their queries.
